#### **BONDING PROPOSAL**

Shall East China School District, St. Clair County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Forty-Nine Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$49,250,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

acquiring and installing instructional technology and instructional technology equipment for school buildings; remodeling, furnishing and refurnishing, equipping and re-equipping and installing security measures for school buildings; erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings; remodeling, equipping, developing and improving athletic fields, athletic facilities and playgrounds; and developing and improving driveways, parking areas and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2016 is 1.10 mills (\$1.10 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.02 mills (\$2.02 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$13,890,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is approximately \$-0-. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

#### **OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

1.

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Memphis Community Schools, St. Clair and Macomb Counties, Michigan, be renewed by 17.9532 mills (\$17.9532 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, and also be increased by 0.0468 mill (\$0.0468 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2017 is approximately \$1,446,114 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2016 levy and a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Memphis Community Schools, St. Clair and Macomb Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2016 to 2020, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2016 is approximately \$231,740?

#### Proposal 1

### District-Wide Learning Environment Improvements

Shall the Port Huron Area School District, County of St. Clair, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$125,890,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds for the purpose of defraying the cost of:

- constructing new school district buildings, including a replacement elementary school, and a new early childhood center, and additions to existing school district buildings, including flexible learning spaces;
- remodeling existing school district buildings and classrooms, including safety and security, energy conservation and climate control, and classroom improvements;
- furnishing, refurnishing, equipping and reequipping school district buildings;
- improving and developing sites, including traffic flow, sidewalks, parking areas, playgrounds, outdoor athletic facilities and other improvements in the school district;
- acquiring and installing instructional technology, technology infrastructure and equipment in and connecting new and existing school district buildings?

The estimated millage to be levied in 2016 to service this issue of bonds is 2.70 mills (\$2.70 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds of this issue is 4.22 mills (\$4.22 per \$1,000 of taxable value). The estimated millage increase in 2016 over the 2015 debt levy for proposal 1 is 2.66 mills and for proposals 1 and 2 combined is 3.55 mills. The bonds may be issued in one or more series, payable in the case of each series in not to exceed 30 years from the date of issue of such series. The School District currently has \$26,655,000 of qualified bonds outstanding and \$0 of qualified loans outstanding under the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program. The School District does not expect to borrow from the program to pay debt service on these bonds. The computed millage rate may change based on changes in circumstances.

(Under State law, bond proceeds may not be used to pay teacher or administrator salaries, routine maintenance or repair costs or other School District operating expenses.)

#### Proposal 2

### **Additional Improvements and Climate Control**

Shall the Port Huron Area School District, County of St. Clair, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Twenty Seven Million Five Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$27,505,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds for the purpose of defraying the cost of:

- constructing additions to and/or remodeling of existing school district buildings, including a magnet school and classrooms, roofing replacements, and heating, cooling and climate controls;
- furnishing, refurnishing, equipping and reequipping school district buildings; improving and developing sites, including parking, playgrounds and other improvements in the school district; and acquiring and installing instructional technology, technology infrastructure and equipment in and connecting school district buildings?

The estimated millage to be levied in 2016 to service this issue of bonds is 1.11 mills (\$1.11 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds of this issue is 0.90 mills (\$0.90 per \$1,000 of taxable value). The estimated millage increase in 2016 over the 2015 debt levy for proposal 2 is 0.85 mills and for proposals 1 and 2 combined is 3.55 mills. The bonds may be issued in one or more series, payable in the case of each series in not to exceed 30 years from the date of issue of such series. The School District currently has \$26,655,000 of qualified bonds outstanding and \$0 of qualified loans outstanding under the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program. The School District does not expect to borrow from the program to pay debt service on these bonds. The computed millage rate may change based on changes in circumstances.

### RENEWAL OF BLUE WATER AREA TRANSPORTATION MILLAGE

"Shall the limitation on the total amount of all taxes which may be assessed against all real and personal taxable property in the City of Port Huron, St. Clair County, Michigan, be increased up to 0.6214 mills of the taxable valuable (62.14 cents per \$1,000 of state taxable value) as finally equalized for each of the next four (4) years, to expire in 2020, for the purpose of providing funds, estimated to be \$347,900 for the first year of levy, for the City of Port Huron's share of the operation of the Blue Water Area Transportation Commission for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2020? This is a renewal of a 2012 millage passed for the same purpose.
