Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Wales Township of 0.6 mills (\$0.60 per \$1000.00 of taxable value), reduced to 0.5805 (\$0.58 per \$1000.00 of taxable value of property) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted mill of 0.6 mills (\$0.60 per \$ 1000.00 of taxable value of property) and levied for four (4) years, 2019 through 2022, inclusive, for contracting fire protection services, raising an estimated \$91,466.45 in the first year the millage is levied?
