Call to Order:

The hearing was called to order by Judge Tomlinson at 1:33 p.m.

Roll Call:

All present

Approval of Meeting Minutes from October 27, 2025:

Motion to approve was made by Waters and seconded by Roberts-Burnett. All approved, motion carried.

Public Comment:

Paul Cassidy – Stated objections to the language of both petitions. He indicated he felt the wording was vague and no policy was stated in the "OHM" petition. He also stated that he felt the "Champion Auto Ferry" language was inaccurate, did not clearly stated the role of Mr. Bryson, was vague and did not cite violation of law.

Commission Discussion and Determinations:

Recall Petition - "OHM" language

- Waters stated she felt the language was not clear, particularly that voters would not necessarily know what "OHM" referred to. Roberts-Burnett agreed. Tomlinson also agreed and stated that the language does not identify any policy that was violated.
- Waters made a motion to reject the language, seconded by Roberts-Burnett.

Result: Motion by Waters to reject the petition language passed by a 3-0 vote.

Recall Petition – "Champion Auto Ferry" language

- Roberts-Burnett stated she felt the language was clear; Waters agreed. Tomlinson noted that determining truth or falsity is not within the committee's scope and agreed that the language was sufficiently clear for voters to look into the facts.
- Waters made a motion to accept the language, seconded by Roberts-Burnett.

Result: Motion by Waters to accept the petition language passed by a 3-0 vote.
