### Public Comment:

Jennifer Galliker, Columbus Township Deputy Clerk – Galliker wanted to express concerns as a resident and stated that there was an alleged attempt to cash her tax payment twice which resulted in an overdrawn account.

## **Commission Discussion and Determinations:**

### **Recall Petition: Kim Hetzel**

Tomlinson discussed that the responsibility of the Election Commission is not to determine the truth or falsity of the statements, but rather to determine whether the language is clear enough for both the officer and voters to understand the wording on the petition. Tomlinson stated that he felt the language was clear and straightforward and that it provided a list of statements allowing voters to determine for themselves whether the claims were accurate. Waters seconded the determination regarding the clarity of the language. All were in favor.

**Result: The clarity of the petition language passed by a 3-0 vote.**
