NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Primary Election will be held on **Tuesday, August 6, 2024**. The polls on **Election Day** will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. **Early Voting** is available **Sat., July 27- Sun., Aug 4, 2024**, see below for Early Voting times for your jurisdiction. The following is a brief description of the candidate offices and ballot proposals that will appear on the ballot:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the following partisan offices will appear on the ballot: U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative in Congress, State Representative, all County Offices, all County Commissioners, all Township offices and delegates to the Democratic Party and Republican Party county conventions. The following non-partisan offices will also appear on the ballot: specified offices for Algonac City.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that all St. Clair County electors will be voting on four (4) proposals: 1) a St. Clair County Veterans Affairs Millage-.10 mills for period of six (6) years used to provide financial aid to veterans and their families and financial support for the administration of the St. Clair County Dept. of Veterans Affairs. 2) a Renewal of Road Improvement Millage- renewal of .2495 mill for a period of four (4) years used to improve and maintain roads, streets and highways within St. Clair County. 3) Renewal of Drug Investigation and Prosecution Task Force Millage- renewal of .5598 mills for a period of four (4) years to provide funds for the operation of a drug task force. 4) an Additional St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Millage- of .4944 mills for a period of three (3) years to provide additional funds to be used and dispersed for the purpose of acquiring, developing, and maintaining parks and recreational facilities.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Burtchville Township electors will be voting on a renewal back to the original rate of one half of one mill for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of the Burtchville Township bus transportation.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Casco Township electors will be voting on a renewal of 1.00 mill for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing road maintenance and improvements.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE China Township electors will be voting on a new millage of 1.00 mill for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing road and ditch maintenance and improvements.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Clyde Township electors will be voting on two proposals: 1) a renewal of .25 mills for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing general operating expenses for the Clyde Township Fire Department. 2) a renewal of .75 mills for a period of four (4) years for the exclusive purposes of maintaining and/or expanding existing fire protection levels, payment of fees charged to the Township for fire coverage provided to the Township by other departments, creating a capital improvement funds for fire protection, and/or reduce or eliminate fees charged for service calls.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Fort Gratiot Township electors will be voting on a police protection millage with Headlee restoration with an increase of 2.5 mills for four (4) years to restore the Township's ability to fully levy a previously approved millage of 2.5 mills.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Mussey Township electors will be voting on a new millage of 1.0 mills for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing fire and emergency services, including operations, personnel and facilities. If approved, this millage would replace a previously authorized millage of .5 mills that expired with the 2023 levy.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Port Huron Township electors will be voting on two proposals: 1) a millage renewal not to exceed 0.875 mills for a period of four (4) years for the purpose of providing busing service within the Township. 2) a millage renewal of 1 mill for a period of four (4) years for the purposes of constructing, improving, and maintaining local roads.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE St. Clair County Community College District electors will be voting on a Headlee override millage restoration of .1112 mills for 2024 and thereafter in order to restore a 1.5 mill operational levy previously approved by the voters for the purpose of funding general operations of the college.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE Almont Schools electors will be voting on two Almont Community Schools bond proposals: 1) Almont Community Schools shall borrow the sum of not to exceed \$10,050,000 for the purpose of erecting, furnishing and equipping an addition to the primary school building; remodeling school buildings; and preparing, developing and improving playgrounds, athletic fields and sites. 2) Almont Community Schools shall borrow the sum of not to exceed \$22,680,000 for the purpose of erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to the high school building; remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; and erecting, preparing, developing, improving and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields, facilities and structures and sites.
